Dear Students, Staff and Parents,

I am writing this letter to inform you that **we will continue with our Yellow Learning when we return to school on February 22<sup>nd</sup>.**

In order to best serve the academic needs of our students, our Yellow Learning Plan continues to remain as follows:

1. **School dismissal will be at 2:00 PM**
2. **Grades PK-5 will attend school Monday-Friday**
3. **Grades 6-12 will attend school Monday – Thursday. Response to Intervention (RTI) for Grades 6-12 will be on Fridays. Students in Grades 6-12 that are referred by teachers will attend school on Fridays for RTI to complete assignments and maintain passing grades. Parents and students will be notified by Wednesday of each week if they need to attend Friday RTI.**
4. **The After School Program (ASP) will continue to run 2-4:40 PM Monday through Thursday.**

Remote learning programs will remain the same for remote learners.

Also, here is updated travel information from the CDC for families that may be travelling during February Vacation:

In accordance with Maine travel guidelines, any staff or students who travel within the US to any state other than New Hampshire or Vermont (no restrictions as of 2/08/21 for these two states only), they will be required to either:

1. Complete a 10-day quarantine upon arrival in Maine and continue to monitor for signs and symptoms for an additional 4 days OR
2. Obtain and receive a negative COVID-19 antigen or molecular (PCR, NAAT, or isothermal) test result within 72 hours prior to arrival back into Maine to forgo the 10-day quarantine.

Please continue to follow best practice safety protocols: wear a mask, keep physical distance, wash your hands and monitor for symptoms, and help protect our schools and neighbors.
